

Amazon Court has DGNB gold certificate

CA IMMO DGNB was awarded gold certificate for Amazon Court building. This is the highest rating possible within the international certification system of German Council for Sustainable Buildings, and Amazon Court is the first project in the Czech Republic with such certification. “We are proud that Amazon Court is the first building in the Czech Republic that won the certificate. During the DGNB certification process not only the building itself was studied from many perspectives, but also its site. Both ecological and economic as well as functional and technical aspects of the project were all taken into account,” says Alois Vyleta, CEO of Czech CA IMMO office. Amazon Court, along with the buildings Danube House and Nile House, is an important administrative centre in the River City Prague Karlín. Amazon Court received the international award Mipi Architectural Review “Future Project“ Award 2008 (Building the Future) for its original design and technical innovation. Amazon Court also won 1st prize in the Best of Realty in category “New Administration Centre“ in 2010.
