

South Korean property developers coming to Beroun

South Korean property development firm will soon begin building a residential complex Na Veselé in the Beroun Golf Resort. The project will offer 94 flats in two residential buildings with 128 parking spaces. In the first phase, which will be launched in the first half of this year, there will be 38 1 to 4-bedroom housing units. Ivo Chvojka and Jan Šabart are the project's architects, an association of companies T.A.Q. and Interma is its contractor. The investor is Tifannys, owned by South Korean firm KOS WIRE EUROPE.

Na Veselé should not only build on success of the golf course, which was put into operation in May 2009, but also on the positive response to the already existing housing project Beroun Golf Residence.
