

Bratislava plans to gimmick up the Zlaté piesky area

The Bratislava city council plans to develop and gimmick up the Zlaté piesky area. „The urban study is worked out, which after agreed at the city council will serve like a base for the elaboration of changes and annexes to the capital planning scheme as well as land planning base on the zone level for regulation of the land using and the elaboration of the land planning schemes of zones“. The recreation area is mainly used in summer season.

Summer operation ought to also remain the dominant in future, but he proposes to add the area with year-round used facilities like covered halls, running paths or bike paths and uncovered game areas.

„The multifunctional town-wide area of leisure time focused on water sports also contains possibilities of the artificial ice-area creation. Besides, here are created possibilities for natural ice areas, which could be safely used in winter season, for example cove of rowing path,“ the deputy stated. Gyms, courts, swimming places, fitness centre, children or football game areas with natural grasses ought to also grow in the area. Besides green areas the study propose a park, to make areas of static and dynamic traffic green, for example malls, trees and low green areas at parking places in terms of the city planning scheme.

The recreation area has 184,83 ha, including the area of the lake with the island. They want to build-up the new entrance to the area from south direction. Changes would also touch traffic, the southern sector would be accessible through overpass of motorway from Ivánska cesta with variant connection to Mokráň and Záhon Streets, south-eastern sector would be accessible from the crossing Cesta na Senec and Vajnory. The trolleybus rail would be prolonged from Rádiová Street to Zlaté piesky and the tram rail by northern outskirt (Senecká) to Vajnory.
