

Kempinski Hotels heading to Marienbad

Hotel chain Kempinski is planning construction of three new hotels: in Russia, Armenia and Mariánské Lázně (Marienbad). All new associated property should become tempting attractions and centres and should thus contribute to development of the entire region. The Marienbad facility will be the second Kempinski hotel in the Czech Republic, apart from Kempinski Hybernská Prague. The hotel in Prague opened in 2008.
